



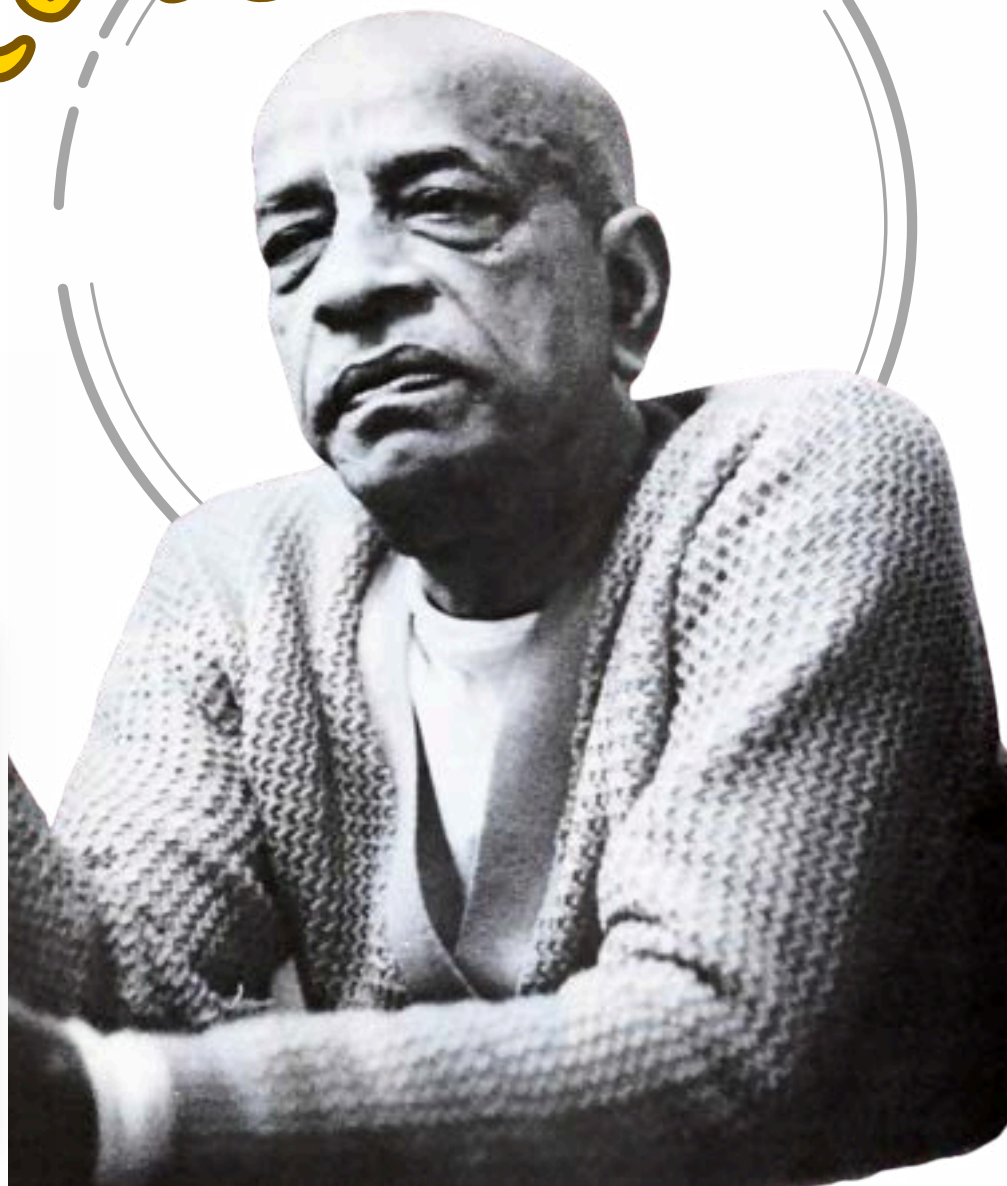

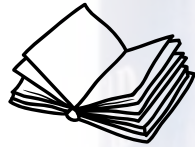

Spreading the Light of Srila Prabhupada's Books: ISKCON Dublin

Dear Devotees,
Please accept my humble obeisances,
ISKCON Dublin has made remarkable strides in book distribution over the past few months, sharing the teachings of Lord Krishna through Srila Prabhupada's books. Since April, the temple has distributed over 3,000 books and four complete sets of the Srimad Bhagawatam. Their efforts have earned them notable rankings across Europe: 14th in April with 1,094 books, 33rd in May with 150 books, 18th in June with over 1,535 books, and 43rd in July with around 200 books. These fluctuations reflect both seasonal dynamics and the collective push across European countries to

take advantage of the warmer weather to increase outreach through Harinam and book distribution. We were inspired by the presence of HH Dayananda Swami Maharaj for the Harinam this month demonstrating book distribution to devotees.

I would like to share from the diary of HH Tamal Krishna Goswami Maharaj, Bhagavan presented some books, one of which was in Italian, one in French, and one in Dutch. He also said that the book distribution in Europe had surpassed that in America.

"Tamala, do you hear that? This is my life! Come here," Śrila Prabhupāda said; and he blessed Bhagavan with his lotus hand, as

tears fell from his eyes. "What class of people are you distributing to?" asked Śrila Prabhupāda.*

"All classes of men," Bhagavān replied. "Many intelligent persons are joining."

"It is due to book distribution," Śrila Prabhupāda said.

Srila Prabhupada emphasized the importance of spreading Krishna consciousness by encouraging devotees to prioritize outreach—leaving only one person in the temple while others engage in Harinam and book distribution. This mission is not merely about numbers; it's about offering people the chance to hear about Krishna and experience the joy of spiritual life.

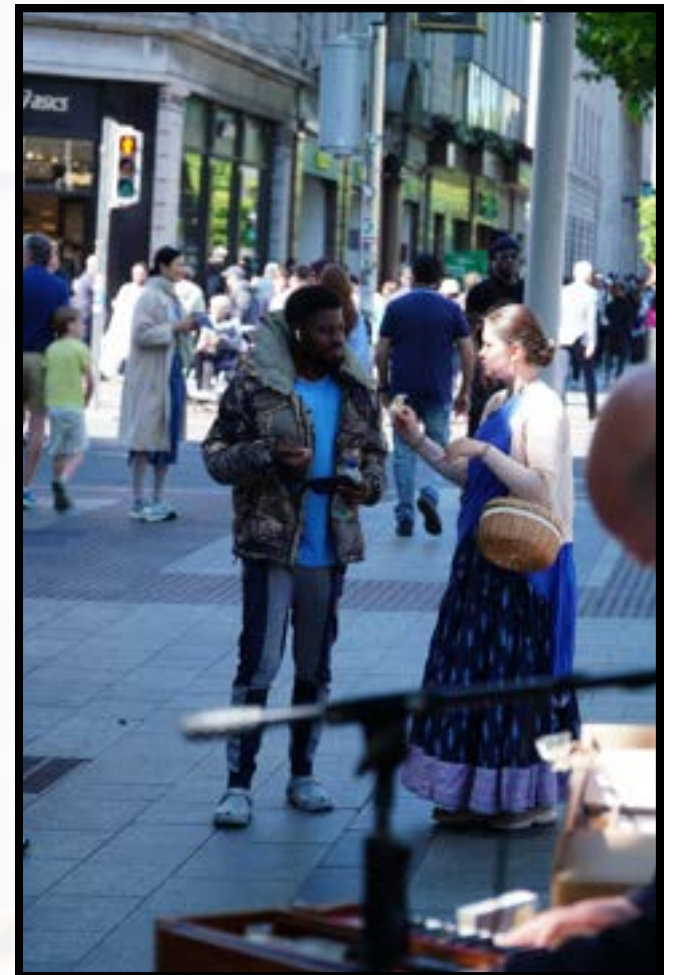

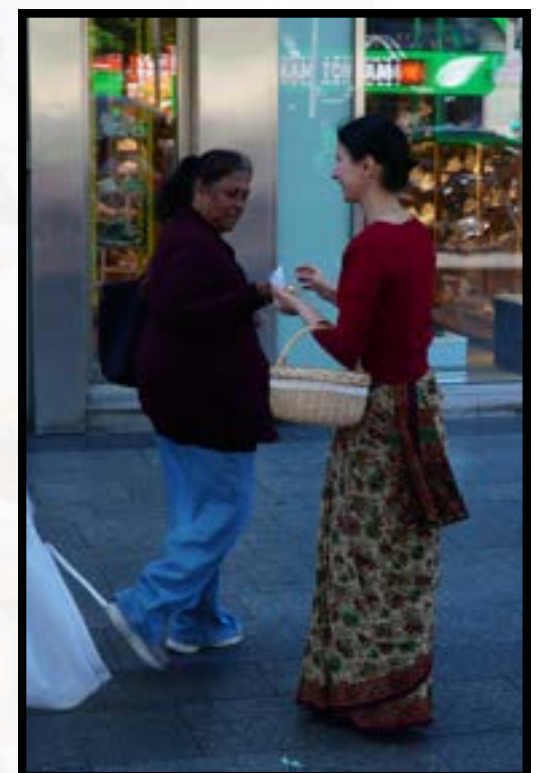

This milestone was made possible by the blessings of our acharyas and the enthusiastic service of a dedicated team of volunteers.

The program at DCU was nothing short of inspiring. The evening began with vibrant kirtan, which soon had the audience joyfully dancing and clapping along to the holy names. Following the kirtan, a short interactive discussion introduced participants to the essence of bhakti, answering heartfelt questions in a simple and relatable way. The highlight, as always, was the prasadam distribution, where everyone relished sanctified vegetarian food lovingly prepared by devotees.

The response was overwhelming—around 80 people attended the program, and many expressed how uplifted and energized they felt. Several students remarked that the event was not just a cultural experience, but a refreshing boost of positivity and spiritual energy in the middle of their busy

Looking ahead, we are delighted to announce that the Discover Yourself course will soon be launched in DCU, with plans to gradually expand into other colleges across Ireland. This marks the beginning of a new chapter in sharing Krishna consciousness with the youth of Ireland—planting seeds of devotion that will surely blossom in the years to come.



Expanding Compassion with Food for Life Dublin

Dear Devotees,
Please accept my humble obeisances.

Since I last wrote to you with an update about Prabhupada's Food For Life program, it has expanded further and now distributes prasadam to the public six nights a week. Malati-Mala Devi Dasi manages three nights—Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays—while Keith manages Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

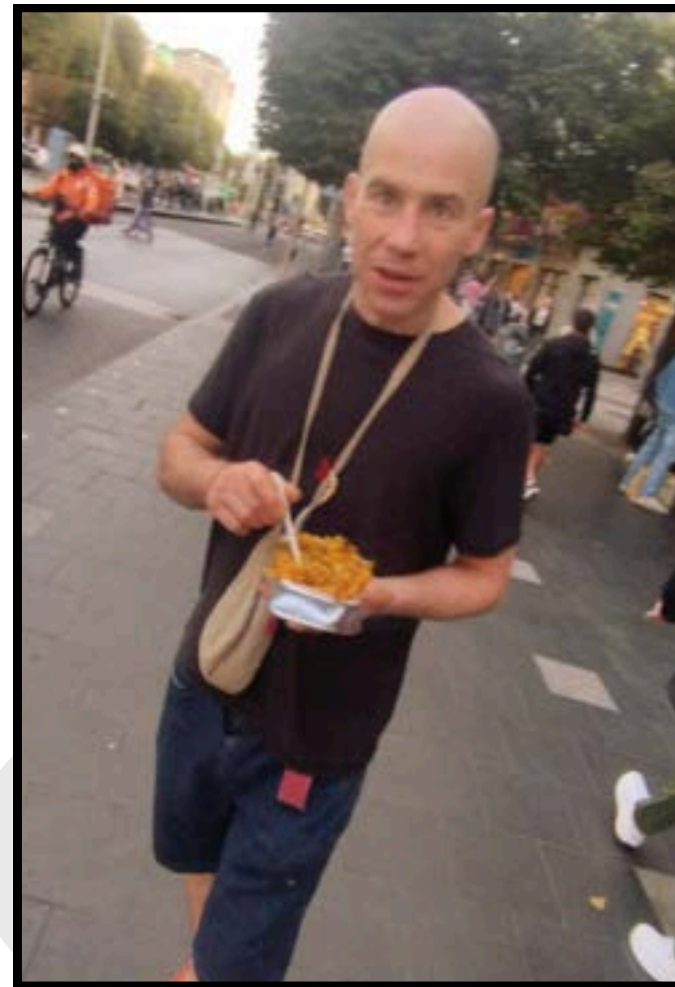
By the Lord's mercy, the program now serves an average of **268** plates of food each evening. The total number of plates distributed so far is **43,248**, of which **33,326** were served in this year alone. In fact, ISKCON Dublin is on course to provide at least **52,000** hot meals to the public in 2025.

This growth has been made possible through the generous sponsorship of Kalindi, whose noble spirit has allowed the program to expand so rapidly. Her support has even enabled us to renovate the storage space next to the first-floor toilets. What was once home to nesting pigeons and miscellaneous junk is now a watertight storeroom with proper shelving and electricity. It now serves Food For Life, Feasts and

Festivals, Matchless Gift's ISKCON merchandise, the cleaning team's paraphernalia, and the temple's building and maintenance equipment.

While all glories belong to Srila Prabhupada, we should also offer gratitude and appreciation, without any particular order, to:

- Shyam and Tim, for managing the accounts;
- Vibhor, Tanushi, and Kamlesh, for painting the new storeroom;
- Malati-Mala Devi Dasi, for managing three nights a week—sometimes cooking, distributing, and cleaning all by herself—and inspiring countless Ukrainian refugees in the process;
- Everyone who contributes ingredients and sponsorship each week, allowing us to carry on our seva;
- The many distributors, especially those who come week after week and always treat the public with respect and kindness;
- Jai Jagganath Das, for the tireless seva he does;
- Manu for his subtle hand guiding the program and keeping us all in line so that we serve Krishna;

- Jivana Das, for ordering the vegetables and fruits and managing the lifeblood of Govinda's;
 - Aydo, for always offering a helping hand and spending countless hours scrubbing the kitchen clean;

For many, the Sunday Love Feast is more than a weekly event—it's a spiritual reset, a moment of

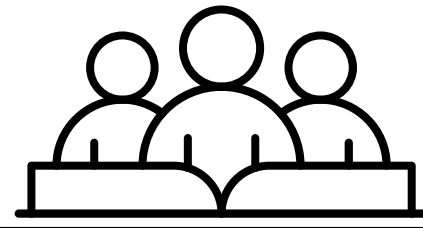

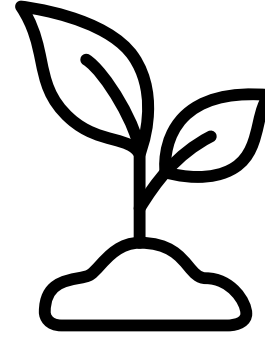

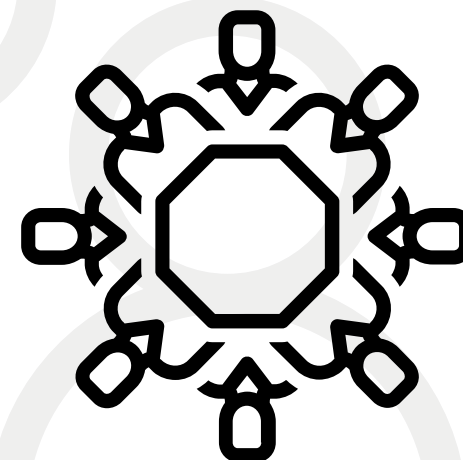
By Kṛṣṇa's mercy, we've had the opportunity to connect with new seekers and create spaces for discussion, reflection, and spiritual nourishment.

Cleanliness is Next to Godliness: ISKCON Dublin's Seva in Action



In ISKCON, we learn from Śrīla Prabhupāda that cleanliness is next to godliness. The temple is not just a building — it is the house of the Supreme Personality of Godhead, Śrī Śrī Radha and Kṛṣṇa, the most sacred place where devotees gather to hear, chant, and serve. Keeping the Lord's home pure and spotless is therefore one of the most important services we can render, and in Dublin, we are blessed to have a dedicated team of devotees carrying out this essential seva with great sincerity and love.

The ISKCON Dublin Cleaning Department is made up of around **30** enthusiastic devotees who work together as one team to ensure that the temple remains a clean and welcoming space for all. Every day from Monday to Saturday, before the clock strikes noon, the temple hall is cleaned thoroughly. This is the very heart of our community, the space where kīrtanas rise, where Bhagavad-gītā and Bhāgavatam classes nourish souls, and where the Deities are glorified. To keep this area spotless is an offering of devotion, a way of saying, “My Lord, I wish to welcome You and Your devotees into a pure and sacred space.”

Beyond the temple hall, the devotees also maintain the stairs

and bathrooms with great care. These areas are cleaned twice weekly, once during the middle of the week and once again on Saturday. Even these seemingly “menial” tasks are acts of bhakti when performed with the consciousness that they are for Kṛṣṇa's pleasure. Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu Himself personally cleaned the Guṇḍicā temple with His associates, demonstrating how pleasing such service is to the Lord. When we sweep, mop, or scrub for His temple, we are following in the footsteps of the Lord and His pure devotees.

Special appreciation goes to **Yuliia** and **Aman** for their consistent dedication to this seva. Rain or shine, they can be found faithfully contributing to the cleaning schedule. Their determination inspires others, showing that steady, humble service is the true foundation of devotional life. I personally also take part in cleaning the bathrooms and temple hall, not only to support the team, but to remind myself that service in the mood of humility is the essence of bhakti.

Looking ahead, we are eager to make the seva experience even sweeter. Very soon, we plan to begin serving prasādam to all who



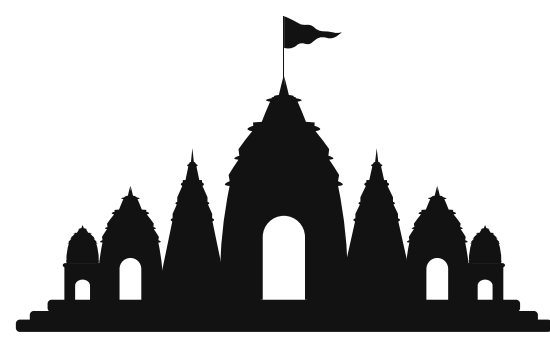

ISKCON Dublin New Temple Project



Dear Devotees,

ISKCON is close to buying the land just outside Dublin to build a beautiful temple and community facility. It will also include farmland for growing food and a small Goshalla (cow protection area), creating a spiritual and self-sustaining environment for generations to come.

In May, we identified a suitable property, and two weeks ago we successfully negotiated the best possible price. By Krishna's grace, the community has already raised €30,000 in just two weeks, but we must keep up the momentum.

We humbly request your support in helping us through any contribution you can make will go towards buying the land for the temple.

We have surpassed our target of €285,000, which we needed, achieving a total of €286,745.

Excess funds will be used for survey, legal, and other expenses, but all contributors will be honoured for having helped purchase the land for Kṛṣṇa's temple.

This is all due to the incredible mercy of our beloved Deities, Śrīla Prabhupāda, our spiritual guides,

and the hard work, sacrifice, and commitment of all of you. To have achieved this figure in such a short time is truly miraculous.

Now we wait for 8 days to get our loan approval to buy the land. Then, by Kṛṣṇa's grace, we will go through with the land purchase for Him.

Please have a wonderful celebration this Saturday, and we look forward to being in touch soon with further developments.

Anyone who will donate €501 or more will have their names permanently on the wall of the new temple.

However, every contribution, no matter the size, brings us closer to making this dream a reality and will be permanently remembered in a book of gratitude.

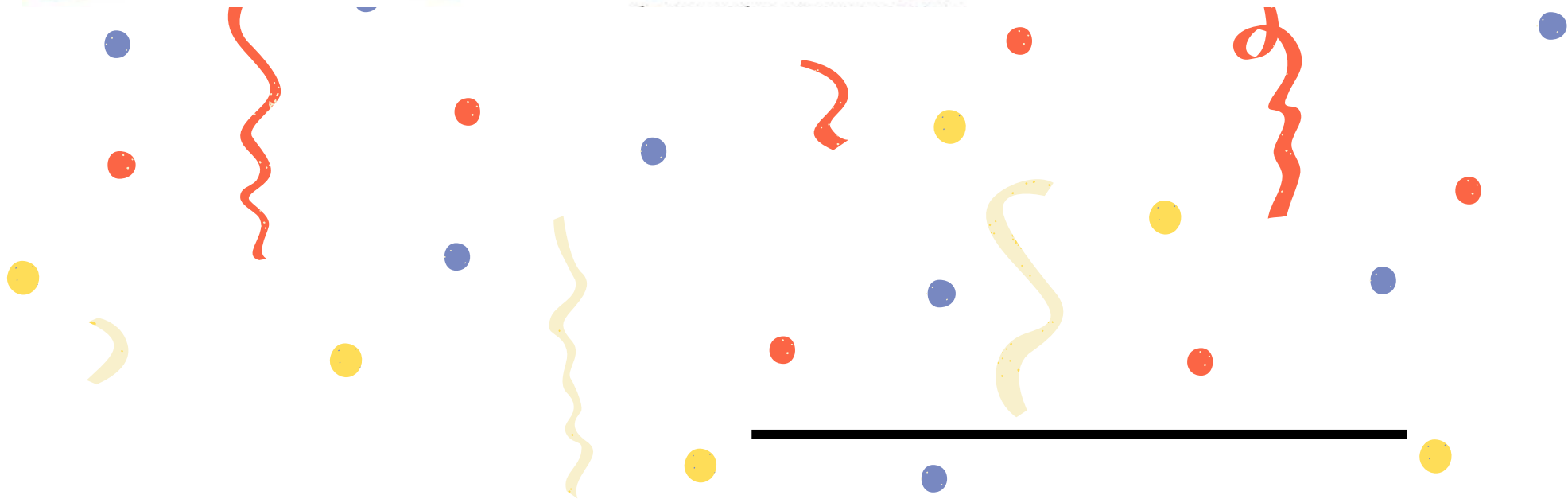

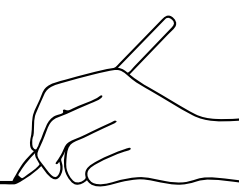
