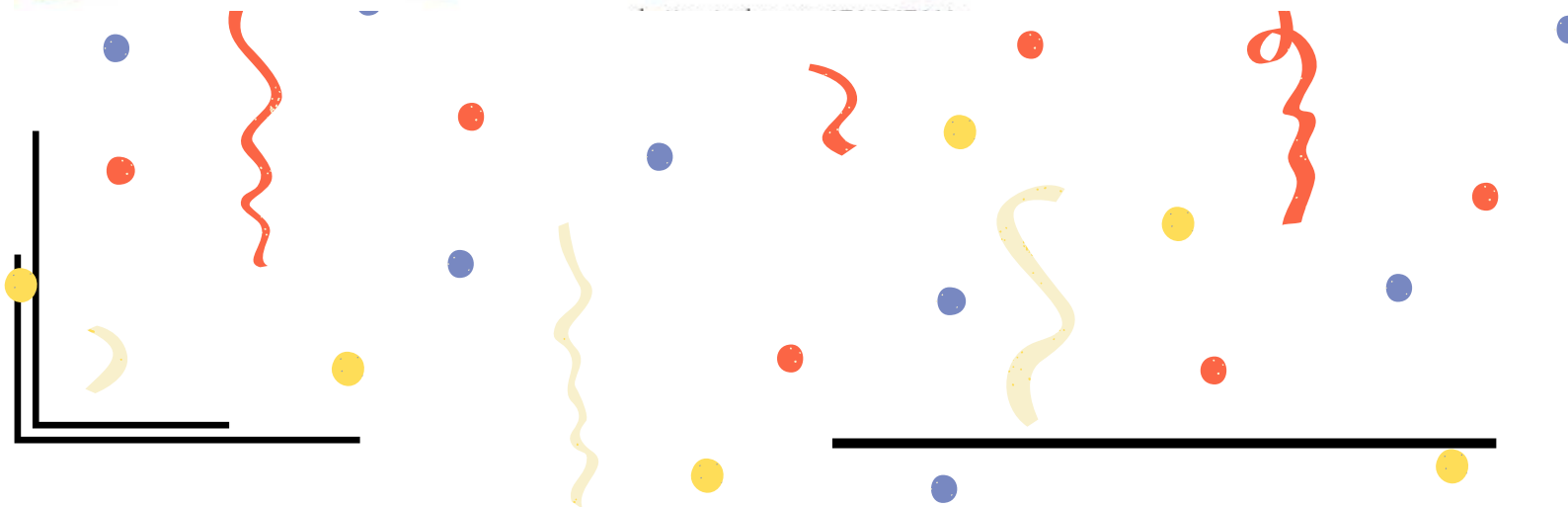


FESTIVAL MOMENTS


HG Sugati Achyut Prabhu welcomed all the guests and devotees. Also, gave the gist of the evening to the audience.

One of the highlights of the evening was the drama "Krishna-Sudama Leela" performed by the ISKCON Dublin Drama Team.



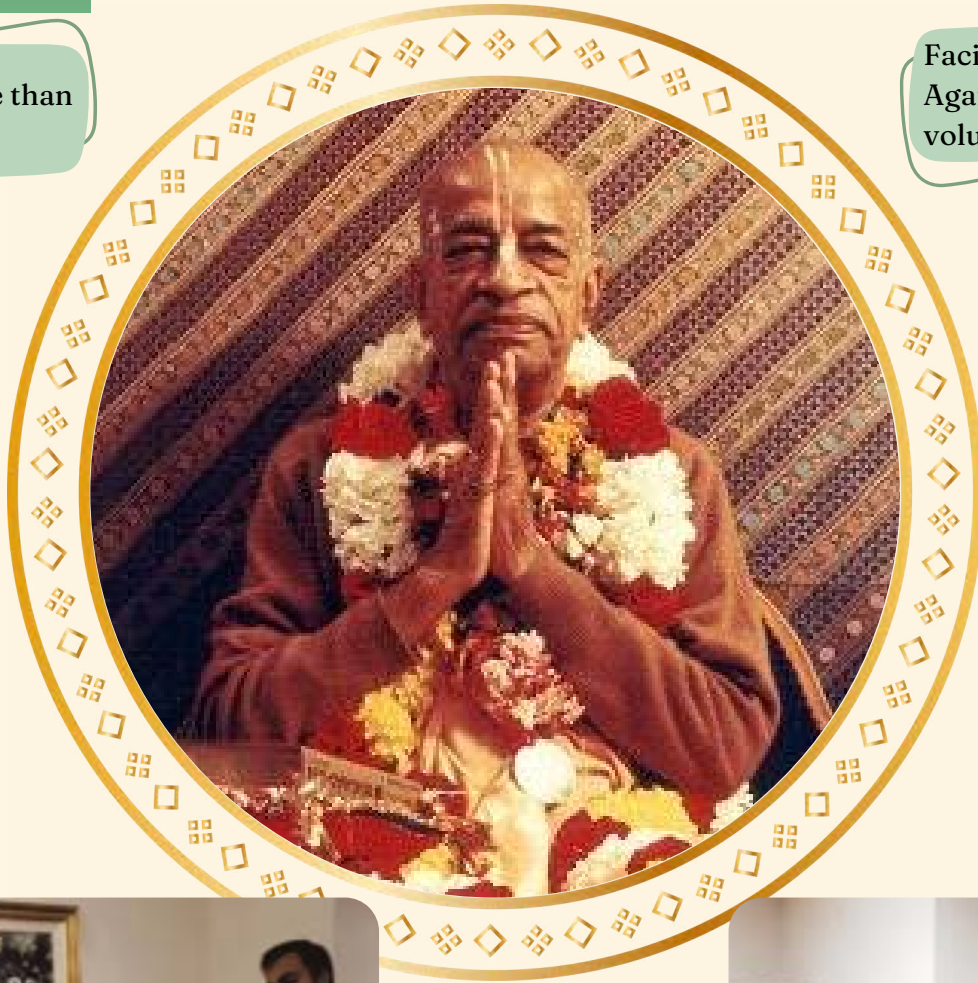
